

Ann-Sofi Klingberg made her debut in Ravels Concerto in G with The Swedish Radio Symphony Orchestra and Neeme Järvi. She has performed in Scandinavia, many European countries and USA. Ann-Sofi Klingberg has worked with many of the foremost Swedish chamber musicians and singers. Highly acclaimed was her recording of Ylva Skog Piano Concerto with Malmö Symphony Orchestra. With KMW pianotrio www.kmwpianotrio.com she has made recordings of trios by Britta Byström, Ylva Skog and Andrea Tarrodi, a portrait CD of Cecile Chaminade and a CD with Armenian Piano Trios.

Ann-Sofi Klingberg is a member of Sonanza, contemporary music ensemble with more than 200 first performances and 9 CD recorded including The Swedish Grammy award. Sonanza represented Sweden in festivals in Berlin, Frankfurt, Hamburg, Prague, Huddersfield, Los Angeles, Odense and Copenhagen among others.

Ann-Sofi Klingberg studied at Royal College of Music in Stockholm with Gunnar Hallhagen and graduated with soloist diploma. She also studied with Mario Conter in Brescia, Italy. Other important teachers in master classes have been Charles Rosen, Vlado Perlemuter, Radoslav Kvapil, David Burge, Bruno Seidlhofer. In her pedagogical profession as lecturer at Södra Latin in Stockholm, a great number of the foremost Swedish younger pianists have been her students.
