

Wang Sisi, Ph.D., is an associate professor in the Vocal Music Department of the School of Music at Shanghai University and a master's thesis advisor.

She graduated from the Shanghai Conservatory of Music and the School of Humanities at Shanghai University, and served as a senior visiting scholar at the China Conservatory of Music.

She has won the Gold Medal at the National Opera Competition for Chinese and Foreign Operas among Higher Art Institutions;

the Gold Medal in the Faculty Category at the 5th "Shenzhou Singing Cup" National College Vocal Competition organized by the China Musicians Association; and the Gold Medal in the Open Category (Art Songs) at the Hong Kong International Vocal Open Competition Finals.

She has been invited on multiple occasions to perform and engage in academic exchanges at world-renowned universities in the United States, France, Germany, Ireland, and various Middle Eastern countries, as well as to participate in the "St. Petersburg Symphony Orchestra National Tour" during the Year of Chinese Culture in Russia.

She has published numerous papers in core Chinese journals such as the *Journal of Nanjing University*, *Contemporary Film*, and *Music Creation*;

and has received grants for general projects under the Shanghai Philosophy and Social Sciences Planning Program.
