During her career as a chamber musician of 30 years, Kristin has toured the world with the internationally known saxophone quartet Rollin' Phones. A lot of Kristins students have won awards in both national and international competitions, and some of her earlier students are now leading saxophonists in the Swedish music scene.

She has plenty of jury experience from being an avid jury member for The Royal Swedish Academy of Music, The Royal College of Music in Stockholm and Lilla Akademien.
