In 2015 he was admitted to the federal musical talent school "Carl Maria von Weber" in Dresden, where he has been taught by Christoph Gerbeth, KV Jens Prasse and Prof. Céline Moinet.

Since then, Nathaniel has won first prizes at numerous competitions such as Jugend musiziert (largest German music competition for young people) in 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 or the 2nd Rising Stars Grand Prix 2017 – International Music Competition Berlin where he performed in the award-winner concert at the Philharmonie Berlin.

He is member of different orchestras such as the Saxony Youth Orchestra, the Young Chamber Orchestra, the Young Symphony Orchestra Dresden and has played in numerous chamber music ensembles with different instrumentations.

Furthermore, he was invited to play with musicians from the Staatskapelle Dresden and Tonhalle-Orchester Zürich and worked as soloist with the Young Chamber Orchestra under Helmut Branny.

Nathaniel received significant musical impulses through master classes with Prof. David Walter, Prof. Céline Moinet, Prof. Burkhard Glaetzner, Prof. Maurice Bourgue, Albrecht Mayer and Ramón Ortega Quero.
