Biography

I started learning the violin as a 4-year-old, and had my dad, Vlastimir Belic, as my teacher till recently. The past 3 years I've studied with Kristoffer Dolatko, and still do.

The first competition I participated in was UMM, here in Norway as a 6-year-old. I've played there every year since, and a few years later, in 2012, I participated for the first time at the Midgard Competition, in Horten. Last year, fall 2020, I won first prize in my category at the Midgard Competition, and also went to the national UMM.

The first time I played with orchestra, I was 8 years old, and I played the whole Winter by Vivaldi with Narvik Symphonic Orchestra. 2 years later, in 2013, I played Saint Saens' 3rd violin concerto, mov 1 with a local orchestra, and 2 years ago I played Haydn, violin concerto in G major, 1st movement with a local string orchestra.

My first international competition was in Elblag, Polen in 2019 where I got 3rd prize. Not long after, in 2020, I went to the finals in Grumiaux's violin competition for young violinists in Brussels, Belgium. Unfortunately, the finals got cancelled because of Covid-19.

This past year, I participated in an online competition; Concorso internazionale per Giovani Violinisti and went through 2 rounds and made it to the finals. The finals will hold place in Rome this summer or later.

I've been to different music courses both national and international, for example in Lagos, Portugal in 2012-2013, and Valdres Sommersymfoni the last 8 years. I have also attended at UngFilharmoni the last 2 years, and I have been accepted this year as well.

Otherwise, I've played at various concerts and some festivals, both solo and in orchestra/chamber music.
