Evangeline Lien made her solo piano debut recital at the age of 9 with a full ovation. The unique sound of the viola attracted her attention, which led her to transition to a violist. By the age of 11, she had passed the MTACalifornia Certificate of Merit advanced level 10 with the state honor, and won numerous international competitions, including the 1st prize of the Music Talent and Judges' Distinction Award of the Romantic Music in the American Protege International Competition, 1st prize of the Golden Classical Music Awards with invitations to perform in Carnegie Hall, 1st prize of the International Music Competition "Bonn and Salzburg" Grand Prize Virtuoso with invitations to perform at Beethoven-Haus in Bonn and Solitär Mozarteum in Salzburg, 1st prize of the Greece Muse International Competition along with the 3rd prize of overall winners, 1st príze with Menzione Speciale of the 31st Young Musician International Competition "City of Barletta", Grand Prize in overall Strings Category of the Vancouver International Music Competition, 1st prize of the North International Music Competition, 1st prize with Judge's Favorite of the Vivo International Music Competition, 1st place at both the 21st Century Talents and Rocky Mountain Concerto Competitions, Grand Prize and Audience Award at the Royal Sound Music Competition, Grand Prix of the Festivalul de arte International Strings & Chamber Music Competition, 1ER PRIX of the France Music Competition, Grand príze overall (top performer runner up) of the US New Star Stríngs Competition, Viola Performing Gold Star of the Music & Stars Awards, and 1st príze Californía State winner in the Opus Music Competition.
