

Curriculum Vitae

Denisa Geislerová (1995) has been dedicated to music since her childhood (choir, recorder, flute). In 2014, she became a student at the Prague Conservatory in the class of professors MgA. Jan Ostrý and MgA. Jana Ryšková. During the years 2018-2021 Denisa was studying at the Faculty of Arts at the University of Ostrava in the class of MgA. Anna Stavělová. She graduated with a bachelor's degree and received a diploma with honors. In 2019, she went on a one-year internship in the Netherlands under the Erasmus+ program, where she was working with professor MA Aldo Baerten at the Utrecht Conservatory. Since 2022, she has been studying Master's degree program of flute at the Royal Conservatoire of Antwerp with Aldo Baerten.

During her studies, she successfully participated in several national and international competitions. Her greatest achievements include for example, the 2nd prize from the International Woodwind Competition in Wroclaw, the 2nd prize from the Flautiada International Flute Competition in Bratislava and the 1st prize from the National Competition Pardubické dechy in Pardubice. In 2022, Denisa was invited to the semifinals of the International Woodwind Competition Carlo Maria Giuliani in Bolzano and was also chosen as a participant for the 9th International Flute Competition in Krakow 2023. She has been successful at auditions in the Czech Republic as well and in 2021 was accepted to the National Theatre Orchestra in Prague as a solo piccolo/2nd flute player. Since then, she has been employed full time as an orchestra player.

Denisa regularly performs with numerous Czech orchestras, such as Pilsen Philharmonic Orchestra, North Bohemian Philharmonic Orchestra Teplice, West Bohemian Philharmonic Orchestra Mariánské Lázně, Film Philharmonic Orchestra, the Czech Student Philharmonic Orchestra in Prague (Dvořák's hall in Rudolfinum) and also Radek Baborák's Ensemble.

She has attended several international flute masterclasses, where she has had the opportunity to work under the guidance of world-famous flutists, such as Philippe Bernold, Clara Novakova, Catherine Cantin, Hansgeorg Schmeiser, Michel Moragues, Nathalie Rozat, Ilze Urbane, Renata Penezic, Christine Fassebender and others.
