

Bio for Mila Haydon

Mila began to play violin at the age of four. She has attended masterclasses at the Blackmore Academy in Berlin, the Mozarteum University in Salzburg and Music masters in Venice. She has also attended classes in Interlaken, Madrid, Stockholm, Ankara, Zhuhai and Shanghai.

At a young age Mila has been awarded first prize at the Open Age Jan Baxter Memorial Strings Scholarship Solo in Wollongong Eisteddfod, as well as in several string festivals in Canberra and in Sydney Eisteddfod.

She was a member of the Australia National University (ANU) and the Canberra Youth Orchestra, as well as a frequent performer at the Young Performers of the Music Open School ANU. She has also been soloist with Canberra CYO Orchestra and at the Wesley Music Centre Rising Stars concert series.

Since 2022, Mila studies at the Reina Sofía School of Music with Violin Chair with professor Zakhar Bron. She has been granted a scholarship by Fundación Albéniz.

As a student of the School, he has been a member of the Fundación EDP Camerata, conducted by Christoph Poppen.
