Performer's Biography - Rose Light

An accomplished violinist at age 19, Rose's string quartet won the Queensland International Chamber Music Competition 2019 (Under 18s), she won First Place in the International Noteable Instrumental Competition 2022, Second Place in the Wellington Youth Concerto Competition 2023, her piano trio won the 2021 NZCT Contest Silver Award and she was a Semi Finalist in the NZ National String Competition 2021. Rose was selected as one of six Violin Fellows for the Michael Hill International Violin Competition 2023. She was awarded her Licentiate of Music Diploma with Distinction in 2020. Rose began her tertiary studies in her home country of New Zealand and now studies in Austria at the Kunst-Universitat Graz, under Prof. Vesna Stankovich for violin and Prof. Alexander Pavlovksy for chamber music.

Rose has performed as a soloist with the Australian Haydn Ensemble and the Australian Honours Ensemble String Orchestra and played twice at the Sydney Opera House with Staatskapelle Berlin and the Australian World Orchestra as a member of the Regional Youth Orchestra of NSW. She is a recipient of the Barbara Finlayson Violin Scholarship and the Raukaraka Leadership Scholarship at the University of Wellington. She plays on a Riccardo Bergonzi Violin 'Vivace' c.2005 available through a generous loan by the Hill Family Foundation for Art and Music.

She has worked in professional orchestral roles including Co-Concertmaster of Orchestra Wellington performances with the Royal New Zealand Ballet and she won an audition for a permanent First Violin Seat with Orchestra Wellington. She has been Concertmaster of six different youth orchestras across Australia and New Zealand and was the youngest member of the Australian Youth Orchestra NMC in 2019. Rose has played in orchestras under numerous international conductors including Daniel Barenboim, Riccardo Muti, James Judd and Ariel Zuckermann.

Rose is equally passionate about sharing her love of music through performance and teaching. She is working towards a professional life where she is able to perform as a chamber musician and with orchestras as well as teaching at universities
