

ANNA-PELAGEA PETROV

Anna-Pelagea Petrov was born in 2014, Tallinn, Estonia. From the beginning of the life Anna was surrounded the classical music, attending sacred music concerts performed by her parents. Anna-Pelagea's father Valery Petrov is the composer and conductor of the choir ensemble, mother Maria Peterov is a classical singer. Anna-Pelagea has begun violin studies from age three with the violin teacher Katrin Talmar. At the age of 7 years old Anna-Pelagea entered the Tallinn Secondary Music School (TMKK), which has transformed from 2022 into Tallinn School of Music and Ballet (MUBA). Anna has continued studying violin with teacher Elo Tepp.

In 2023 at the age of 8 Anna-Pelagea has made her first debut as Concert soloist with Tallinn Chamber Orchestra, taking part in project „MUBA Virtuosoosid“ (Virtuosos of MUBA). In 2023 Anna-Pelagea won the third Prize on the Xth Stockholm International Music Competition.

In 2024 Anna won the third place on Estonian competition „The Best Young Instrumentalist“, and also in 2024 she has got a Honorable Mention on Victoria International Violin Competition in Barcelona (Spain), jury president Viktor Tretyakov.

Anna has attended violin professor and Vienna Philharmonic concertmaster and soloist Alexander Shonert's masterclasses in Czech Republic and has performed as a soloist in various concert halls in Estonia, together with string quartets and the ensemble of folk instruments.
